DRY EYE PRESCRIPTION INSURANCE CHECKLIST

Please review before we send your prescription.

Insurance coverage varies by plan. Checking your formulary first helps avoid delays and unexpected costs.

Common Prescription Dry Eye Medications

Your doctor may recommend one of the following:

- **Restasis**® (cyclosporine ophthalmic emulsion 0.05%)
 - **Cyclosporine ophthalmic emulsion 0.05%** (generic)
 - **Cequa**® (cyclosporine ophthalmic solution 0.09%)
 - **Vevye**® (cyclosporine ophthalmic solution 0.1%)
 - **Xiidra**® (lifitegrast ophthalmic solution 5%)
 - **Miebo**® (perfluorohexyloctane ophthalmic solution)
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Why Check Your Insurance?

- Know your **copay or cost**
 - See if **prior authorization** is required
 - Prevent treatment delays
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How to Check

Choose one: - Log in to your insurance **member portal/app** - Search the medication under **drug coverage/formulary** - Call the number on the **back of your insurance card** and ask: - Is this medication covered? - What is my copay? - Is prior authorization required?

Also ask if a **specific or mail-order pharmacy** is required and whether there are **quantity limits** (30 vs. 60 or 90 days).

What to Do Next

- Once you know which medication is covered, contact our office and we will send the prescription.
- If prior authorization is required, let us know so we can submit it.
- If costs are too high or nothing is covered, tell us—we can discuss alternatives or savings programs.

Checking first helps us start your dry eye treatment faster.

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
